

Sky and Clouds Jello Celebrate the Feast of the Assumption



On the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary we remember when Mary was taken into heaven, body and soul, after she died.

Why would God take Mary's body and soul into heaven? Mary is special to God: she said "yes" to becoming the mother of Jesus. God also wanted to show us that one day, all of us will share in the bodily resurrection of Jesus. Mary is the first person in the Church to experience the resurrection in its fullness.

Ingredients

- 2 small boxes of blue Jello
- 2 cups boiling water
- 2 to 3 cups ice cubes
- 1 container of cool whip

Instructions

1. Dissolve the Jello powder in 2 cups of boiling water.
2. Add the ice cubes and stir until the Jello starts to firm up and can hold its shape. (Refrigerate for about 20 minutes if needed)
3. Cover the bottom of the jar/bowl/glass with blue jello.
4. Add two spoonfuls of cool whip on the edges and shape it into a cloud.
5. Add another layer of jello to just cover the clouds.
6. Repeat until you run out of jello.
7. Refrigerate for 2 to 4 hours before serving.
8. Say the Hail Mary before eating. Enjoy!
