

PASTOR'S CORNER

What does your personal prayer life look like? Does prayer happen daily or only as needed? Has it changed at all over time? Matthew Kelly offers some points to consider for those who would like to improve their prayer life.

Six Seismic Spiritual Shifts Regarding Prayer presented by Matthew Kelly

- 1. Just be open to beginning a conversation with God
- 2. Ask God what He wants and especially ask for direction instead of material things.
- 3. Give yourself to prayer Let God do what He wants to do.
- 4. Transform everything into prayer offering everything that we do as acts of prayer to God.
- 5. Make myself available to God by consecrating myself to Him in the Eucharist.
- 6. Just keep showing up no matter what. It is all about what God is doing to us and in us.


Trust - Surrender - Believe - Receive

WEEKLY PARISH OFFERTORY BUDGET - has increased by just over \$3000. The budget figure we have been providing in the bulletin had not been changed in over a year. Still, operating costs have increased over time. Our Parish Finance Council and I have noted that \$15,385 more accurately reflects the average amount needed to fund the day-to-day expenses incurred for the operation of our parish. We hope that providing you with a more representative figure of the actual costs will prompt parishioners to review the amount they contribute weekly/monthly, especially if they have not increased their giving in quite some time. Over the past few years we have had to use some of the proceeds of our Grand Annual collection and savings to help pay for these operational expenses. However, the actual purpose of the Grand Annual collection is to fund larger extraordinary maintenance, upgrades, replacements and repair costs for the church, parish center, rectory, Thank you for your anticipated and grounds. generosity to help us reach this new budget figure. -Fr.
