PASTOR'S CORNER

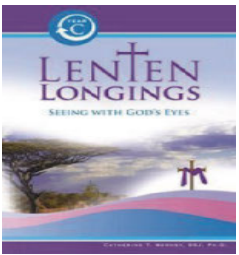

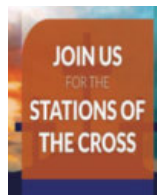

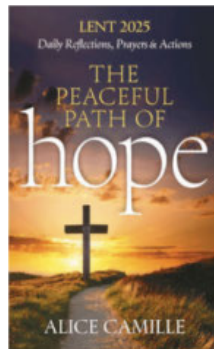
LENTEN REGULATIONS

ABSTINENCE: Catholics over 14 years of age are bound to the obligations of abstinence, to be observed on Ash Wednesday and the Fridays of Lent. On days of abstinence, meat may not be used at all.

FAST: Catholics over 18 and up to the beginning of their 60th year are bound to the obligation of fasting. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fasting. On these days, only one full meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids, including milk and fruit juices, are allowed.



FAMILY STATIONS OF THE CROSS & PIZZA - Beginning this Friday, March 7, and all Fridays during Lent at 5:00 pm, please join us in the church for stations. Following stations, please come for pizza in the parish center. Stations are family friendly, as is the atmosphere, but all are welcome!



LENTEN DEVOTIONALS - There are Lenten devotionals by the doors this weekend. These Lenten aids provide daily reflections, prayers and actions for Lent 2025. In this Jubilee Year, Alice Camille invites us to make a Lenten pilgrimage in Jesus' own path. In the face of accusation and persecution, she writes, Jesus shows us that "only hope can make a person brave." Take one to help make your Lenten season a fruitful one with great hope!

Dear Parishioners,
Nuestros Pequeños Hermanos (NPH) supports over 9,000 vulnerable children and individuals in Latin America and the Caribbean, an organization that Holy Family Parish has supported for many years. Today I write to you about our home and programs in Haiti where there is an **emergency need**. NPH supports over 3,500 individuals from Haiti's capital to the mountains of Kenscoff where our main campus and home are located. Throughout the last few weeks, due to violence in the Kenscoff area, NPH's main children's home was compelled to open its doors to accommodate 392 refugees, including 145 children. These individuals and children have lost everything, their homes, belongings, food, and clothing. To continue helping them, we urgently need funds to purchase sacks of rice, beans, and oil to feed both the refugees and the children that are part of NPH. We ask that you please consider making a financial donation towards the \$40,000 emergency fund to allow NPH to continue aiding our refugees, and to keep NPH Haiti in your prayers.
