PASTOR'S CORNER

This Sunday, Palm/Passion Sunday, begins Holy Week, the time in our liturgical calendar when we celebrate the central mysteries of our faith, what the Church calls the Paschal Mystery – Jesus’ passion, death and resurrection. We reflect upon what God has done for us in the unique expression of His mercy and love through Jesus’ offering of Himself in sacrifice to the Father for the forgiveness of our sins. Having triumphed over evil, sin and death upon His resurrection from the dead, Jesus gives us hope that we too can triumph over all that would otherwise overcome us. This is made possible because Jesus has shared with us His risen life - His divine power, first received at our Baptism, and renewed each time we receive Eucharist. We are a people of hope because of Jesus!

Are you in need of hope these days? Let these mysteries of our faith speak to your heart, allowing Jesus to reassure you. Place your burdens and sorrows, your weaknesses and sins, your doubts and fears on the cross with Jesus. At Mass, let Jesus lift them up to the Father for you as an offering to be transformed into something life-giving. Allow the Paschal Mystery be a source of encouragement and hope as you persevere along the road to Calvary with Jesus, holding onto the expectation of sharing in His Easter victory. I invite you to come to the special liturgies of Holy Week and celebrate the great mysteries of our faith and the hope they bring. See the schedule in this week’s bulletin. If you haven’t been to any of the solemn celebrations of Holy Week called the Triduum, which include the Mass of the Lord’s Supper on Holy Thursday, the Good Friday Solemn Commemoration of the Lord’s Passion, and the great Easter Vigil, you’re in for a special treat and an uplifting spiritual experience. 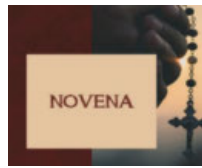

 **HOLY FAMILY DUXBURY** | A ROMAN CATHOLIC PARISH



DO YOU HAVE A HOME/APARTMENT TO RENT? - In 2021, residents of our community started what's called the Duxbury Afghan Resettlement Initiative (DARI) to assist Maruf Wazirwal, his wife, Zia, their 5 children and nephew, refugees

from Afghanistan, to find housing here in Duxbury. Since Maruf had been a security guard at the U.S. airbase in Jalalabad, the family needed to flee their home in Kabul to avoid reprisals from the Taliban. With the help of Catholic Charities and First Parish Church, they were able to come to Duxbury and live in the parish's vacant parsonage. At this time, First Parish Church needs to make their home available for a new minister they anticipate receiving in June. The family has been embraced by our community and is thriving, making great strides in learning English and gaining new skills. The children are excelling in school and activities; and Maruf works in the maintenance department of Duxbury Public Schools. DARI is urgently searching for a rental home or apartment (can be a 3 bedroom) within 20 minutes of Duxbury schools, ideally in the \$3,000/month range, which is a stretch given the family's limited income. However, DARI will commit funds to supplement what the family cannot afford up to \$3,000/month. The family and DARI together are prepared to commit immediately. 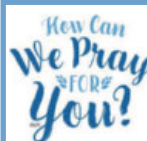

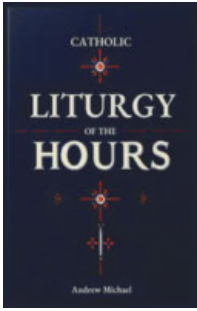

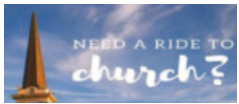

their time to God's glory. This prayer also provides a structured prayer routine, helping individuals to establish a consistent prayer life and focus on God throughout the day. Did you know that Holy Family offers Evening Prayer (part of the Liturgy of the Hours) every Friday evening at 5 pm in the chapel? Also during Holy Week, we pray Morning Prayer (another part of the Liturgy of the Hours) on Holy Thursday (4/17), Good Friday (4/18), and Holy Saturday (4/19) at 8:15 am. Why not try out this type of prayer between now and Easter and see if it might be something you want to incorporate more regularly in your prayer routine? HOLY THURSDAY- VISIT SEVEN LOCAL CHURCHES - The Seven Churches Pilgrimage is the practice of visiting seven different churches on Holy Thursday, in imitation of the journey of Christ on the eve of his crucifixion. Several

area churches are joining together to invite parishioners to do this pilgrimage locally. Pilgrims undertaking this journey anywhere in the world can visit any seven churches while adoring Christ in the Blessed Sacrament upon the Altar of Repose, fulfilling His request of His disciples to stay with Him as He awaited His Passion. There are specific Scripture passages that pilgrims can meditate upon at each altar. It's a time for reflection on Jesus' suffering and love for humanity.
