

Pastor's Corner

Do you remember hearing your mother say, "Be careful whom you make friends with!" She knew associating with someone who would not be a good influence could cause you to do something you'd later regret; for example, you might get in with the wrong crowd. She may have also wanted to protect your little brother, who looks up to you, from being negatively influenced by the bad language or behavior exhibited by you and your friends. In Matthew 18:6, Jesus warns that "Whoever causes one of these little ones who believe in me to sin, it would be better for him to have a great millstone be hung around his neck and be thrown into the sea." Giving good example is an imperative Jesus gives us that some neglect to consider. Are you unwittingly giving bad example by your association with unscrupulous influencers who espouse patterns of behavior that are not in keeping with our Christian values? How would you feel if you heard your child or grandchild use demeaning or disparaging language that imitates what's coming out of your mouth or the mouth of someone you've been listening to? Our culture is becoming ever more uncivil, crass, divisive and, in many ways, unchristian, especially when people of influence, leaders we would otherwise look up to, are not giving us and our families good example to follow. Reflect upon how you are negatively influenced - but still, may be ready to give it a pass. Let's pray for courage and a greater recognition of the importance of giving good example and avoiding bad example, and the role we have in our spheres of influence to help change the direction of our culture with positive and uplifting examples of what should be the norm in our society.


